This announcement is made in reference to the Announcement of College of Music Mahidol, University on “The Resumption of Teaching and Learning” at the College of Music during Coronavirus 2019 Pandemic, dated January 28, 2021.

College of Music, Mahidol University is announcing the resumption of teaching and learning, and the staff operation during Coronavirus 2019 Pandemic as follows.

1. Academic and support staff will resume normal operations.
2. Teachers and staff who reside in or has traveled to the strict and highest controlled areas (in accordance to the Announcement of the Center for the Administration of the Coronavirus 2019 Pandemic) since January 15, 2021 are required to teach or study online until February 14, 2021 and to inform your supervisor or instructor (as the case may be). During this period, the supervisor or instructor may assign additional tasks or provide appropriate lessons. Such period will not be counted as absence.
3. All College of Music staff should follow the social distancing guidelines, including;
 - 3.1 Avoid using public transportation during rush hours.
 - 3.2 Avoid being in crowded places/communities or doing group activities. Reduce unnecessary social activities to avoid possibility of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) infection.
 - 3.3 Take care of your own health by washing your hands with water, soap or alcohol sanitizer, avoiding touching your face, sneeze or cough on tissue or arms, etc. You should also keep distance from those suspected to have disease without making them feel socially isolated.
 - 3.4 Be responsible for yourself and others by informing your supervisor and related persons immediately if you are suspected to be infected by Coronavirus 2019.

3.5 Follow the information, news and other announcements from Mahidol University frequently.
