

Details for Pre-College Music Technology Department Position (Music Technology with Science)

Overview

The (Pre-College) Young Artist Music Program (PC - YAMP) is part of the College of Music, Mahidol University with our own specialized building.

(Pre-College) Young Artist Music Program is the only pre-college program in Thailand that offers the combination of music and education with multiple life-skills development. The program distinguishes itself from any other program with our international faculty members and vast music performance opportunities that each student is entitled to. In addition to the private one-to-one lessons with faculty members, each student is also involved in small, chamber or large ensembles in which students gain valuable practical experiences. The cultural campus where YAMP is situated provides a tremendous music and arts environment including the renowned Thailand Philharmonic Orchestra and numerous international conferences and competitions.

We are therefore searching for teachers who **love** to teach the last three years of High school (M4-6), have the **knowledge** of 21st century learning techniques * and the **enthusiasm** to work hard in developing our students.

* Student-centred, differentiated, project based learning.

A love of and/or active participation in music/performing arts is preferred but not essential.

Specifically, we are looking for:

- A degree in education or music technology with very strong English skills
- Excellent subject knowledge and an interest in the wider curriculum.
- Ability to teach across all age ranges, utilising various styles of teaching.
- A proven track record of consistently good/outstanding teaching.
- Natural authority and presence within the classroom.
- The ability to negotiate behavioural problems to retain authority within the classroom
- The ability to differentiate materials and teaching methods to meet the needs of the learners.
- An understanding of the issues involved in developing the curriculum M 4 – 6 (UK Yrs 11-13, USA Grades 10-12)
- This teaching position is to be responsible for teaching music technology and some Science courses e.g. Physics of Sound and Acoustics.

All PC-YAMP based teachers are expected to be involved with:

- Lesson planning and preparation
- Checking and assessing work
- Attending staff meetings
- Liaising with parents
- Monitoring break and extra-curricular activities
- Ongoing professional development
- Homeroom teaching and Guidance classes
- Usual contact time per week is between 20-25 hours
