Guidelines for Academic Provision and Work from Home to Strengthen Control Measures of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)

Reference is made to the Announcement of Mahidol University on Guidelines for Academic Provision and Work from Home to Strengthen Control Measures of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) dated the 30th April 2021. The College of Music is announcing as follows.

1) Measures Regarding Academic, Research and Other Activities

1.1 All buildings and premises of College of Music Mahidol University are prohibited to be used for teaching and learning, examinations, trainings or any other activities involving a large crowd. Teaching and learning activities are to be offered online and other activities such as internships/practicums and assessments can be cancelled or adjusted to reflect the online teaching and learning methods, as seen appropriate.

1.2 Activities with a total number of attendees exceeding 50 people are also not allowed in Mahidol University Salaya Campus.

2) Measures Regarding Work-from-Home

College staff members are requested to work from home during the 1st – 16th May 2021. College staff members are allowed to work on-site in the College pending the authorization of the Dean. Measures to ensure staff's safety and to reduce the exposure to the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) are to be strictly observed.

3) Students and staff members in all campuses are advised to wear masks at all times and strictly observe the D-M-H-T-T guideline to prevent further transmission of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).

Please be advised accordingly and this Announcement enters into effect from this date onwards until further notice.
