

Announcement of College of Music, Mahidol University On Additional Guidelines on Teaching and Learning and Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)

Reference is made to the Announcement of College of Music, Mahidol University on Guidelines on Teaching and Learning and Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) dated June 29, 2021.

As the continuation of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic situation is expected to adversely affect the quality of teaching and learning at the College of Music, The College is therefore announcing additional guidelines regarding teaching and learning as follows.

1 Teaching and learning

- 1.1 Small ensemble classes shall be postponed to start on August 2, 2021, unless agreed upon among all students and teacher that the class should start online prior to August 2, 2021. The student who intends to study this class online prior to August 2, 2021 can submit his/her intention via https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1An2MSliFwxdCPmfUxeFzRVEjV94tV9k2ztlmZDAkBKM/edit. The number of the lessons delivered must be in accordance to the requirements of the related program. The Chamber Music Centre of the (Pre-College) YAMP will announce separate updates.
- 1.2 Large ensemble class schedule shall follow the College's Large Ensemble Project-Based Schedule which shall be announced on the College of Music Mahidol University Academic System (COMMAS). (Pre-College, YAMP will announce Large ensembles separately)
- 1.3 Major and minor performance lessons shall be postponed to start on August 2, 2021, unless agreed upon between all students and teacher that the class should start online prior to August 2, 2021. The student who intends to study this class online prior to August 2, 2021 can submit his/ her intention via https://forms.gle/FpdhcdechRAgRq9G7. The number of the lessons delivered must be in accordance to the requirements of the related program.
- 1.4 Regarding internship, entering the site shall follow the guideline and regulation of the organization where the student interns.
- 1.5 Other groups of subjects, including lecture and hybrid lecture/practical subjects shall start online in accordance to the referenced announcement of June 29th.

2 Use of Buildings and Facilities

2.1 The College's practice rooms, consisting of practice rooms in building D, 2nd and 3rd floors (for undergraduate and graduate students) and building Young Artist Music Program Building (for YAMP students), shall be open for services from Monday – Friday (9.00am – 6.00pm) and from Saturday – Sunday (1.00pm – 5.00pm), except on public holidays.

In order to abide by social distancing policies, only one student can use a practice room at a time and a student can use the practice room facilities for not more than 2 hours per day.

To reserve a practice room, please contact 02-800-2525, ext. 5575 (for YAMP practice room reservation) or 4105 (for Building D practice room reservation) from 1.00pm – 5.00pm on the College's working days. The reservation should be done within Thursday in order to use the practice room on Monday – Sunday of the following week.

- 2.2 The department chair shall gather the information of the department members' intention to enter to the college and submit the "Monthly College Entrance Request" to the channel specified by the College of Music.
 - The buildings shall be opened from 7.00am 7.00pm from Monday Friday (except public holidays). Teachers are not allowed to stay in the room with the student.
- 2.3 The College's library is open on Monday Friday (except public holidays) for limited number of users. The library user must pass the checkpoint provided by the College in order to enter the library.

This announcement enters into effect from the date of this announcement until otherwise announced.

Please be advised and act accordingly with reference to these guidelines, as well as constantly follow up with further announcements of College and University.
