

Announcement of the College of Music, Mahidol University On

Guidelines for Operations under the State of Emergency Announcement

Reference is made to the Announcement of Mahidol University on Guidelines for Operations under the State of Emergency Announcement dated the $10^{\rm th}$ July 2021.

College of Music Mahidol University would like to announce guidelines for operations as follows:

- 1. Staff members and students residing in or having to commute through the 6 highest maximum controlled areas (Bangkok metropolitan area and its adjacent provinces), including Bangkok, Nonthaburi, Pathum Thani, Nakhon Pathom, Samut Prakarn and Samut Sakorn, are advised to work from home and participate in teaching and learning through the online systems. Only if necessary, some staff members may be authorized by Dean or Associate Dean.
- 2. All departments are authorized to offer online teaching and learning, assessments and other academic activities through online systems as seen appropriate and not allowed to use buildings and facilities, practice room, library until Mahidol University announces a relaxation measure.
- 3. The College is encouraged to cancel or postpone social functions and other activities with participants more than 5 people, except those religious and traditional ceremonies. All measures relating to the prevention of the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) must also be strictly observed in all these events and ceremonies. The College planning to use the premises for activities with participants more than 5 people, a permission from their respective local authorities is required. The College is to conduct an online self-assessment via the Thai Stop Covid+ in order to report to the Committee for Disease Control of Nakhon Pathom Province for consideration.

Please be advised accordingly and this Announcement enters into effect from this date onwards until further notice.
