



Announcement of the College of Music, Mahidol University
Criteria and Rates of Scholarships for the General Prem Scholarship Fund
College of Music, Mahidol University, 2021

Whereas it is appropriate to prescribe criteria and rates of scholarships for the General Prem Scholarship Fund, the College of Music has done so according to the regulations of Mahidol University on the Management of the General Prem Scholarship Fund, 2019.

By virtue of article 7, paragraph 2 of the Mahidol University regulations on the Management of the General Prem Scholarship Fund, 2019, the College of Music Administrative Committee, with approval from the College of Music Board of Directors, in the meeting No. 2/2021 on July 16, has established the following criteria and rates for scholarships for the General Prem Scholarship Fund.

No. 1: Scholarship Amount

The College allocates scholarships for the year 2021 to students as free scholarships in the amount of 80,000 Baht per academic year, with a total of 24 scholarships as follows:

- Prem Music Fund Scholarship	20 Scholarships
- Kuning Patama Leeswadtrakul Scholarship	1 Scholarship
- Dr. Boon Vanasin Scholarship	1 Scholarship
- Disphol Chansiri Scholarship	1 Scholarship
- Rumpa-Wasin Kamnerdrat Scholarship	1 Scholarship

No. 2: Recipient Qualifications

2.1 Is a student who has been selected and accepted for admission at the College of Music or a student who is currently enrolled.

2.2 Is a student in need of financial assistance or student with outstanding musical ability.

2.3 Is an applicant who has good behavior and has never violated the disciplinary rules of the College.

2.4 Must not be a recipient of another type of College scholarship.

No. 3: Submission of Scholarship Application Documents

Students who want to apply for this scholarship can contact the Student Affairs Office to obtain and submit the application form and the following required documents:

3.1 One-inch photograph (attached to the application form).

- 3.2 Copy of Government ID card or student ID card (1 certified true copy).
- 3.3 Copy of house registration (1 copy).
- 3.4 Copy of student grade report (1 copy).
- 3.5 Copy of the acceptance letter to study at the College of Music, Mahidol University (1 copy) for the case of section 2 (2.1).
- 3.6 Documents for musical ability (1 set) in case of applying for a scholarship in the category for outstanding musical ability.
- 3.7 Set of documents presenting reasons to apply for a scholarship, financial difficulties and expectations for study (1 set) in case of applying for a scholarship in the category of financial need.

No. 4: Criteria for Consideration and Selection Method

4.1 The Student Affairs Office, College of Music, Mahidol University examines the qualifications of applicants and sends the applications with supporting documents to the General Prem Scholarship Fund Committee, which are then presented to the College of Music Administrative Committee.

4.2 The College of Music Administrative Committee considers and approves the allocation of funds under this announcement.

4.3 The Student Affairs Office, College of Music, Mahidol University brings the list of scholarship recipients for announcement to the general public.

No. 5: Disbursement of funds under this announcement will be distributed only once. The scholarship recipient will receive funding from the College of Music only after enrolling in the College.

No. 6: Disbursement of funds under this announcement will be disbursed from the Prem Music Fund according to the regulations of Mahidol University on Budget and Finance Management, 2008, and its amendments.

No. 7: Compliance and conditions that cannot be carried out in accordance with this announcement will be under the Dean of the College of Music to consider and decide and such decision(s) will be final.
