

Announcement of College of Music, Mahidol University 3nd Additional Guidelines on Teaching and Learning and Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) For 2/2021 Semester

Reference is made to the Announcement of the College of Music, on 2nd Additional Guidelines on Teaching and Learning and Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) For 2/2021 Semester dated January 28, 2022.

In accordance to Thai government's announcement that the country's COVID-19 alert was raised to level 4 on February 21, 2022 and to Mahidol University Announcement on the Prohibition of Mahidol University Premise Use in Salaya Campus under the Announcement on the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (Omicron Variant) in Nakhon Pathom Province dated February 23, 2022, College of Music is therefore announcing additional guidelines regarding operation, and preventive measures for COVID-as follows.

- 1. From February 25, 2022 to March 9, 2022, teaching and learning for all collegiate programs may not be held on campus. Teachers may teach on-line or apply new teaching and learning methods that are considered the most appropriate and beneficial to students under the current circumstances. Examinations during this period will be done online. Related technical requirements and assessment criteria for the tests or examinations can be adjusted as appropriate.
 - Activities in YAMP program shall follow guidelines and announcements announced through YAMP's normal communication channels.
- 2. Staff, faculties, and students who would like to enter the college area are still required to perform ATK test before their entry in March 2022. Every week from the week starting March 7, 2022 to the week starting March 28, 2022, all staff, faculties, and students are required to perform an ATK test before their entry to attend class, perform their duties, or use the college's facilities. The ATK result will be submitted to the College's normal channel (https://forms.gle/v6szCgNou3nSWgut8: the link is also available in COMMAS System) on every

Thursdays during 9am-6pm to enter the college in the following week (from Monday to the end of the week). Anyone who missed the submission timeframe will not be allowed to enter the college. However, additional time frame to send the ATK result is on Mondays during 9am-6pm to enter college on in the same week (from Wednesdays to the end of the week).

This announcement enters into effect from February 25, 2022 onward or until otherwise announced.

Please be advised and act accordingly with reference to these guidelines, as well as constantly follow up with further announcements of College and University.
