

Announcement of College of Music, Mahidol University 4th Additional Guidelines on Teaching and Learning and Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)

For 2/2021 Semester

Reference is made to the Announcement of the College of Music, on 3rd Additional Guidelines on Teaching and Learning and Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) For 2/2021 Semester dated February 25, 2022.

In accordance to Mahidol University Announcement on the Extension of the Prohibition of Mahidol University Premise Use in Salaya Campus under the Announcement on the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (Omicron Variant) in Nakhon Pathom Province dated March 9, 2022, College of Music is therefore announcing additional guidelines regarding operation, and preventive measures for COVID-as follows.

- 1. From March 10, 2022, teaching and learning for all collegiate programs may not be held on campus. Teachers may teach on-line or apply new teaching and learning methods that are considered the most appropriate and beneficial to students under the current circumstances. Examinations during this period will be done online. Related technical requirements and assessment criteria for the tests or examinations can be adjusted as appropriate.
- 2. Activities in YAMP program shall follow guidelines and announcements announced through YAMP's normal communication channels.

This announcement enters into effect from the date of this announcement until otherwise announced.

Please be advised and act accordingly with reference to these guidelines, as well as constantly follow up with further announcements of College and University.
