








On 18 July 2022 - Dr. Narong Prangcharoen, Dean of the College of Music, Mahidol University participated in the ASEAN Youth Winds concert organized by the Ministry of Culture which was a gathering of youth musicians and music educators from 10 ASEAN countries, to provide the opportunities for youth to exchange experiences with world-class artists as well to show their ability and perform music together at the Prince Mahidol Hall, Mahidol University.





On 30 July 2022 - The College of Music, Mahidol University in collaboration with the Office of Contemporary Art and Culture, Ministry of Culture organised a contemporary music performance in honour of His Majesty the King "Rattanakosin, the Kingdom of Siam", on the occasion of His Majesty's 70th Birthday Anniversary on 28 July 2022 at the National Theater (Grand Theater) by Mahidol Symphony Orchestra together with Feroci Philharmonic Society, led by Ajarn Damrih Banawitayakit, Dr. Pamornpan Komolpamorn and Ajarn Navi Hongskul. Closing the Thailand International Composition Festival - TICF 2022 with the Thailand Phil concert under the baton of the Singaporean guest conductor, Maestro Darrell Ang, Chief Conductor of the Sichuan Orchestra of China, featured the vivid orchestral piece by Thailand's own Narong Prangcharoen called Chaotic Noises of Silence Rime. Next comes American composer David Ludwig's Saturn Bells, a piece which evokes the Thailand International Composition Festival (TICF) shapes of Saturn's icy rings. Experienced the Xixia Suite by Chinese-Swiss composer Deqing Wen, an emotionally-moving piece based on a dance drama. Chinese composer Shaosheng Li's The Tale of the Southern Tour then depicts the story of an ancient Chinese emperor's travels to the southern parts of his land. And the program wrapped up with the inventive Fantasia on an Ostinato by renowned American composer John Corigliano.
