Faculty Spotlight: Dr. Wannapha Yannavut, our faculty of the Percussion Department was invited as Guest Artist to attend The 10th National Percussion Workshop held in Gdańsk, Poland from October 19-21 at the High School of Music in Gdańsk, throughout the day there were workshops and masterclasses on topics such as classical percussion, marching percussion, African percussion, drumset, Thai music arrangement for Western percussion instruments, etc. from the guest artists invited from many countries such as USA, Thailand, Nigeria, Ukraine,

and Poland. This year, more than 200 students, percussion musicians and artists attended the event.

Dr. Wannapha is one of the Guest Artists who was invited to deliver workshops and masterclasses on the topic of Classical Percussion ex. Snare drum, Timpani, and also to present the Thai music arrangements for Western percussion ensemble. 
Upcoming Events
