





In this concert, the HK Phil's Resident Conductor Lio Kuokman opens the concert with Ravel's La valse, a work that evokes the glory days of 19th century Vienna, and he concludes with Rimsky-Korsakov's Scheherazade, which depicts the exotic tales of A Thousand and One Nights.
